1. Outreach meetings / Teachers & Student Selection:

During this visit, baseline survey was also conducted. The questionnaire based on various aspects were asked during this survey. The survey was conducted among 20% students enrolment of last three classes.

2. Flash mob by peer educators:

On 14th November 2019, SAATHI team of Tadong Sr. Sec. School celebrated Children's Day with inmates of Freedom Facility Rehabilitation Centre. This centre is authorized to rehabilitate children from Social Justice and Welfare Department, Government of Sikkim.

Likewise, SAATHI team of Namchi Boys Sr. Sec. School had also celebrated children' Day at Pediatrics ward of Namchi Government Hospital.



5. Counselling session at Sang Govt. Senior Secondary School

Counselling on adolescents issues and peer pressure was conducted for the students of Sang Government Senior Secondary School. Ms. Roshni Chettri, Counselling Psychologist from SAATHI team had counselled students on 21st November 2019. Total 36 students had attended the session.



6. Awareness on blood donation:

On 18th November, 2019 Government Secondary School, Mamring organized an awareness program on the benefits of donating blood and encouraged students to participate in it. It was a joined program conducted under the banners of RRC, NSS, SAATHI, VBDAS, SSACS. Guest speaker Mr. Kedar Nath Luitel, Sr. Blood Bank Technician of New STNM Hospital highlighted the benefits of blood donation and encouraged the younger generation to participate in it. He also informed that the blood bank Office has been organizing a blood donation camp on 22nd Nov. 2019 in Pakyong where a large number of blood donors are expected to donate their blood.



7. Community outreach:

A community outreach program on COTPA was conducted on 23rd November 2019 by SAATHI team of Namchi Boys Sr. Sec School with the help of Namchi Police. The peer educators and teacher coordinator along with police personals visited the liquor and paan shops of Namchi. During the visit, the team informed the shopkeepers about COTPA and its consequences and also seized various substances.



7. Other activities:

On 25th November 2019, SAATHI team was invited for an event “Children’s Parliament” at Manan Kendra, Gangtok, East Sikkim. The program was organized under State Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction by Social Justice and Welfare Department, Government of Sikkim. During this event, debate session was organized among children’s parliament on Sikkim Anti Drugs Act. Mr. Kunga Nima Lepcha, Hon’ble Minister, Education Department, Government of Sikkim was chief guest of the event.



On 1st December 2019, SAATHI team attended World Aids Day Commemoration at Chintan Bhawan, Gangtok, East Sikkim. The event was organized by Sikkim State Aids Control Society.
